About TT Firs Neue

TT Firs Neue is a contemporary reincarnation of the good old Scandinavian TT Firs sans-serif. In the process of updating the old typeface, we realized that the number of innovations and the amount of work done definitely deserve a full-fledged new release, and thus TT Firs Neue has come to life. What has changed? Everything, starting from the proportions of letters and ending with a new formula for the interpolation of weights! So, we changed the proportions of uppercase and lowercase characters; corrected the difference in weight between the letters in fonts of different weights. We changed the basic thicknesses of the strokes so that none of their 18 fonts would stand out with their weight and would be completed following a strict system.

We created completely new Italics and also made changes directly to the style of the typeface and its letters—the letters have become fresher and cleaner from the geometric point of view. The most interesting change in the font is the significant extension of its scope. In addition to usage focused on display matters, the new version implies active use in the text and on the web. With all this, the font's character has even gained some more strength. This can be perfectly seen in the radical extenders of the letters gltf, or in the super-display visual compensators for horizontal strokes in the bold weights of the typeface. Even though the standard display of TT Firs Neue has become brighter and more audacious, you can always calm it down a little by simply turning on stylistic alternates.

In TT Firs Neue, you will find small caps (for Latin and Cyrillic alphabets) and a set of stylistic alternates. In addition to the "standard ligatures", in TT Firs Neue you can find a large number of original ligatures (30 items) for capital letters, which cover popular two- and three-letter high-frequency combinations from Scandinavian languages. In addition, to support the linguistic features of Scandinavian countries, we prepared a set of capital letters with pinned-down diacritics (including their small capital versions). To access this function, you need to use the calt feature (contextual alternates) or enable the second stylistic set (ss02) in InDesign. Full list of OpenType features: ordn, case, c2sc, smcp, ccmp, frac, sinf, sups, numr, dnom, tnum, onum, lnum, pnum, dlig, liga, salt (ss01), ss02, locl, calt.

Examples

They are found through much of North and Central America, Europe, Asia, and North Africa, occurring in mountains over most of the range.

TT Firs Neue Thin 16 pt

Firss can be distinguished by the unique attachment of their needle-like leaves to the twig by a base that resembles a small suction cup.

TT Firs Neue ExtraLight 16 pt

Other species have the upper surface of leaves dull, gray-green or bluish-gray to silvery, coated by wax with variable number of stomatal bands.

TT Firs Neue Light 16 pt

They are large trees, reaching heights of 10–80 m (33–262 ft) tall with trunk diameters of 0.5–4 m (1 ft 8 in–13 ft 1 in) when mature.

TT Firs Neue Thin Italic 16 pt

In most species, the upper surface of the leaves is uniformly green and shiny, without stomata or with a few on the tip, visible as whitish spots.

TT Firs Neue ExtraLight Italic 16 pt

Firs differ from other conifers in having erect, cylindrical cones 5–25 cm (2–10 in) long that disintegrate at maturity to release the winged seeds.

TT Firs Neue Light Italic 16 pt

Examples

Wood of most firs is considered unsuitable for general timber use and is often used as pulp or for the manufacture of plywood.

TT Firs Neue Regular 16 pt

Many are also decorative garden trees, notably Korean fir and Fraser fir, which produce brightly coloured cones even when very young.

TT Firs Neue Medium 16 pt

The western North American population of monarchs west of the Rocky Mountains often migrates to sites in southern California.

TT Firs Neue DemiBold 16 pt

Nordmann fir, noble fir, Fraser fir and balsam fir are popular Christmas trees, generally considered to be the best for this purpose.

TT Firs Neue Italic 16 pt

This insect species migrates from central and north United States and south Canada to Central Mexico (Michoacán and Estado de Mexico).

TT Firs Neue Medium Italic 16 pt

Firs are used as food plants by the caterpillars of some Lepidoptera species, incl. *Chionodes abella* (recorded on white fir).

TT Firs Neue DemiBold Italic 16 pt

Examples

The Leaves are needle-like, flattened, 1.8–3.0 cm (0.71–1.18 in) long and 2.0 mm (0.079 in) wide by 0.5 mm (0.020 in) thick.

TT Firs Neue Bold 16 pt

Identification of the different species is based on the size and arrangement of the leaves, the size and shape of the cones.

TT Firs Neue ExtraBold 16 pt

Other firs can grow anywhere between 30 and 236 feet (9.1 and 71.9 m) tall. Fir Tree Appreciation Day is June 18.

TT Firs Neue Black 16 pt

Firs are most closely related to the genus *Cedrus* (cedar). Douglas firs are not true firs, being of the genus *Pseudotsuga*.

TT Firs Neue Bold Italic 16 pt

Trees are full and dense with strong evergreen fragrance, and are known to be one of the longest lasting after being cut.

TT Firs Neue ExtraBold Italic 16 pt

Silver fir is an important component species in the dinaric calcareous block fir forest in the western Balkan Peninsula.

TT Firs Neue Black Italic 16 pt

The fir prefer cold & humid climate, in northern exposition, with a high rainfall (over 1500 mm per year).

Abies pinsapo is an evergreen tree growing to 20–30 m tall, with a conic crown, sometimes becoming irregular with age.

The cones are cylindrical, 9–18 cm long, greenish-pink to purple before maturity, and smooth with the bract scales short and not exserted. When mature, they disintegrate to release the winged seeds.

Regular 12 pt

It is a large evergreen coniferous tree growing to 40–50 m (exceptionally 60 m) tall and with a trunk diameter of up to 1.5 m. The leaves are needle-like, flattened, 1.8–3.5 cm long and 2 mm wide by 0.5 mm thick, glossy dark green above, and with two blue-white bands of stomata below.

Regular 8 pt

It is closely related to (and in many respects intermediate between) silver fir to the north in central Europe, Greek fir to the south in southern Greece, and Nordmann fir to the east in northern Turkey. Some botanists treat it as a natural hybrid between silver Fir and Greek fir, while others treat it as a variety of silver fir, as *Abies alba* var. *acutifolia*. Another synonym is *Abies pardei*.

Contextual alternates

Contextual alternates option is active by default. It changes the ampersand symbol depending on the case of surrounding letters. For an uppercase text, the ampersand has a cap height. An alternative ampersand is activated for lowercase text.
