About TT Bells

TT Bells combines the elegant softness of antiqua with a complex and daring temper reflected in straight stroke terminals and arrowheaded serifs. The family is based on broad nib, which was typically used for old style fonts and creates these hallmark terminals and serifs. We've taken the best from old style fonts created before the digital age and added sharp and contemporary geometric shapes to the traditional style.

TT Bells refers the spectators and font enthusiasts to the origins and, at the same time, reminds us that we live in the digital era when geometry and screens rule the world. TT Bells is suited for different types of text – from the shortest headings to large text arrays. When the font size is decreased, the boldness and sharpness of the font soften, it becomes more classic.

The fontfamily is created according to the traditional TypeType formula (Thin, Light, Regular, Bold, Black & Italics). We've also enabled the support of a broad number of OT features, which will help you widen the implementation range for this family: tnum, onum, pnum, numr, dnom, frac, case, ordn, subs, sups.

Examples

In 1805, Austria and Russia waged war against France. In response, Napoleon defeated the allied Russo-Austrian army at Austerlitz In December 1805.

TT Bells Thin 15 pt

The Allies responded with the Seventh Coalition, defeating Napoleon permanently at Waterloo in June 1815 and exiling him to St Helena.

TT Bells Regular 15 pt

Napoleon quickly defeated the Prussians, and defeated Russia in June 1807, bringing an uneasy peace to the continent.

TT Bells Black 15 pt

Napoleon was exiled to the island of Elba, and the Bourbons were restored to power. However, he escaped in February 1815, and reassumed control of France.

TT Bells Light 15pt

The Spanish and Portuguese revolted with British support, and, after six years of fighting, expelled the French from Iberia in 1814.

TT Bells Bold 15 pt

Examples

The fundamental reorganisation of German and Italian territories into larger states, and the establishment of radically new methods of conducting warfare.

TT Bells Thin Italic 15 pt

For its part, Russia decided that the intervention in Switzerland indicated that Napoleon was not looking toward a peaceful resolution of his differences.

TT Bells Italic 15 pt

The wars fostered the spread of nationalism and liberalism, saw the rise of the British Empire as the world's foremost power.

TT Bells Black Italic 15 pt

One reason for this was Napoleon's changes to the international system in Western Europe, especially in Switzerland, Germany and Italy.

TT Bells Light Italic 15pt

he British quickly enforced a naval blockade of France to starve it of resources. Napoleon responded with economic embargoes against Britain.

TT Bells Bold Italic 15 pt

Le gouvernement corrompu et instable de la France (voir Directoire) ne peut ni faire face aux coups d'État, ni à la menace extérieure, privé de ministre comme Carnot ou de général comme Bonaparte, parti en Égypte. Les armées françaises sont battues, notamment par le général russe Alexandre Vassilievitch Souvorov.

V květnu 1803 znovu vypukla válka mezi Francií a Velkou Británií, když francouzská vojska vpadla do Hannoverska náležejícího k britské koruně (britský král byl Hanoverským kurfiřtem). Hned na to Británie zkonfiskovala v přístavech 1 200 francouzských obchodních lodí. Poté Napoleon Bonaparte plánoval dva roky invazi do Anglie.

Czech

General Kutusow verfügte über etwa 120.000 Mann Infanterie und Kavallerie, sowie 640 Kanonen. Das unübersichtliche, stark bewaldete und mit Gestrüpp bewachsene Gelände, welches dazu noch von Schluchten und Höhenrücken durchzogen war, ausnutzend, hatte Kutusow seine Truppen südlich und nordöstlich von Borodino aufgestellt.

German

Preussi, Saksi ja Venäjä muodostivat neljännen liittokunnan 1806, mutta Preussi lyötiin jo lokakuussa Jenassa ja Napoleon valloitti Berliinin muutamaa viikkoa myöhemmin. Preussin armeija ja kuningas perääntyivät Itä-Preussiin, josta käsin vastarintaa vielä jatkettiin. Napoleon voitti Venäjän armeijan Friedlandissa kesäkuussa 1807.

The Helvetian Republic had been set up by France when they invaded Switzerland in 1798.

A Second Coalition formed in 1798 by Great Britain, Austria, Naples, the Papal States, Portugal, Russia, and Sweden.

Regular 24 pt

Great Britain ended the uneasy truce created by the Treaty of Amiens when it declared war on France in May 1803.

TT Bells
Regular 18 pt

The French were willing to cede Malta, Cape Colony, Tobago, and French Indian posts to Britain but wanted to obtain Sicily in exchange for the restoration of Hanover, a condition the British refused.

TT Bells
Regular 12 pt

The Royal Navy disrupted France's extra-continental trade by seizing and threatening French shipping and colonial possessions, but could do nothing about France's trade with the major continental economies and posed little threat to French territory in Europe.

TT Bells
Regular 8 pt

France's population and agricultural capacity far outstripped that of Britain. Britain had the greatest industrial capacity in Europe, and its mastery of the seas allowed it to build up considerable economic strength through trade. This ensured that France could never consolidate its control over Europe in peace.

The British falsely denied that Russia had made an offer and their ambassador left Paris.³⁷ Desperate to avoid war, Bonaparte sent a secret offer where he agreed to let Britain retain Malta if France could occupy the Otranto peninsula in Naples.³⁹

Possible dates include 9 November 1799, when Bonaparte seized power on 18 Brumaire in France; 18 May 1803, when Britain and France ended the one short period of peace between 1792 and 1814; or 2 December 1804, when Bonaparte crowned himself Emperor.

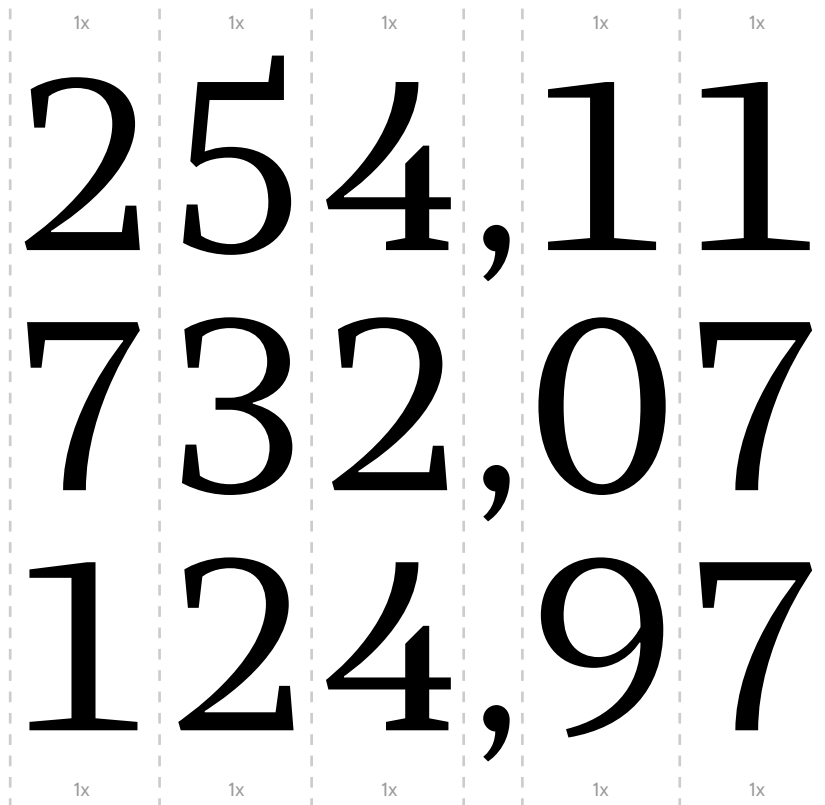
Fractions

1/4 - 1/4

The belligerents declared an armistice from 4 June 1813 during which time both sides attempted to recover from the loss of about a 1/4 of a million men in the preceding 2½ months. During this time coalition finally brought Austria out in open opposition to France.

Tabular Figures

Tabular figures have the same total width, so they don't mix with each other. The consistent width allows tabular numerals to align vertically in financial statements, catalogs, tables, technical notes, and annual reports, or other columns of figures.
