## About TT Wellingtons

TT Wellingtons is an attempt to combine the style of English humanist sans-serifs of the early 20th century with the requirements for modern geometric grotesques. Our main task was to preserve the feeling of hand-written origin of the letters while simplifying their design and making it as functional as possible. One can find many artifacts typical of the traditional technique of poster pen movement on paper in TT Wellingtons.

These are the asymmetric sections of the upper and lower corners of the letters "C" or "3" or the smooth elements of the strokes connection, which are clearly visible in lowercase Latin characters, for example, in the letter "n". The large size of lowercase characters' height and the geometric manner of circle construction—they are pillow-shaped in TT Wellingtons—can be classified as modern type peculiarities. The typeface features a set of stylistic alternates that changes the shape of style-forming characters to a purely geometric one.

TT Wellingtons consists of 9 weights and 9 true Italics. By default, the standard set uses minuscule digits, but if necessary, you can easily turn the lining figures on. The typeface includes more than 20 ligatures, stylistic alternates and other useful features. The full list of OpenType features used in TT Wellingtons is: `ordn`, `sup`, `sinf`, `numr`, `dnom`, `lnum`, `onum`, `tnum`, `pnum`, `liga`, `dlig`, `salt`, `ss01`, `ss02`, `ss03`, `ss04`, `case`, `frac`.

TT Wellingtons  
Regular 12 pt

Every five years a year-long slow quake occurs beneath Wellington, stretching from Kapiti to the Marlborough Sounds. It was first measured in 2003, and reappeared in 2008 and 2013. It releases as much energy as a magnitude 7 quake, but as it happens slowly there is no damage.

TT Wellingtons  
Regular 8 pt

The four cities comprising Wellington have a total population of 416,700 (June 2017), with the urban area containing 99.0% of that population. The remaining areas are largely mountainous and sparsely farmed or parkland and are outside the urban area boundary. More than most cities, life is dominated by its central business district (CBD).

It became much more affordable in terms of cost of living relative to cities worldwide, with its ranking moving from 93rd (more expensive) to 139th (less expensive) in 2009, probably as a result of currency fluctuations during the global economic downturn.
